1. **The Community Health Services Division** is a team of healthcare professionals who provide a wide range of quality medical services to all Greene County residents. They include...
  - a. Blood Pressure Screenings
  - b. BCMH – Bureau for Children with Medical Handicaps.
  - c. Communicable Disease Program
  - d. Dental Services for children, adults and seniors.
  - e. Flu Clinic
  - f. Immunization Clinic...childhood/adult and overseas travel.
  - g. Reproductive Health Clinic...Sexually Transmitted Infections.
  - h. TB Program
  - i. Well Child Clinic
  - j. Women's Health Services...Pre-conceptual Counseling, Pregnancy Testing, Prenatal Care and Family Planning.
  - k. WIC...Women, Infants and Children.
    - i. Nutrition program.
    - ii. Breastfeeding Peer Helper
2. **Health Education Services**...Markets the Health District's services and programs which promote healthy lifestyles. The Health Education team assists groups and individuals in making informed decisions regarding individual, family and community health issues.
3. **Vital Statistics**...Maintains certificates for all births and deaths which have occurred in Greene County since 1909. A certified copy of a birth or death certificate is available for a minimal fee.
